COMMITTEE & BOARD REPORTS

Vicki Alexander Heriott appeared before the City Council stating they had received a water bill for over \$8,400. Ms. Heriott stated that City Administrator, Kevin Flanagan, and the utility subcommittee had met and reduced the bill to \$3,600 by removing the sewer charges. She felt this was still too much money and felt they were misinformed by a water clerk in city hall. She stated she called and the water clerk told her to contact a plumber. She asked if an employee could come to her residence and the water clerk told her they do not do that. She stated that later she spoke with water superintendent, Carl Chandler, and he went to the residence. He looked in the water pit and the meter was running continuously. Ms. Heriott stated that if an employee would have come out when she first called, the problem would have been taken care of.

John Revolinski made a motion to reduce the water bill to \$1200.00 but the motion died for a lack of a second.
