

Public Safety and Transportation Committee Meeting, 12/2/13, 6:00 p.m. City Hall Council Chambers

Points of discussion

Ledger-Kalen presented the idea of a project from the Trails Council for paved shoulders on Hwy 1 South. The Trails Council is currently applying for a grant that would fund the majority of the project. The grant requires that the city give a commitment of support for the project. Likely this project would not take place until 2018. This project could potentially be rolled into a larger urban highway project with the DOT. No action needed. Resolution will be drafted by Stephen Pedrick (Trails Council Chair), finalized by Kevin Flannagan and presented at the December 16th meeting.

A staff member of Fairfield Community School District asked the committee to consider a no-parking area by Washington School on Jackson. It was decided that Ledger-Kalen should discuss options with Fred McElwee with the school district first and come back to the committee for the January meeting with some options.

Boyer presented a grievance that a citizen has with the City and Police Department. This issue was tabled until a meeting on December 13th at noon to obtain more information.

Don Sanders from SEIBA was present to discuss the Social Host Ordinance that the County had adopted and asked the City to also adopt the ordinance and support the efforts to curb underage drinking. Motion was made by Ledger-Kalen and seconded by Halley to present the ordinance as written to the Council. Motion carried. The ordinance will be presented to Council at the December 16th meeting.
