Anderson started the meeting by asking for a recap of last year from the department heads present specifically asking for Projects that remain incomplete. Projects mentioned included handicap parking at Howard Park, handicap parking at the Civic Center. Anderson asked for an update on cleanup of fire property on S 4th. Vaughan reported that he has been in contact with the property owner and clean up is on schedule.

Next the group addressed citizen concern of fence located at corner of Harrison and S 2nd. Anderson recapped concern presented by citizen to the council. The situation has been extensively researched. The fence was built and is within city code. Accident history since 2009 shows no accidents at the corner. Currently the City does not enforce DOT line of site guidelines. After much discussion Anderson asked the property owners to please evaluate how they might remedy the concern without Council involvement. They were asked to present their ideas or decision at a meeting to be called after 30 days. Both parties were amendable to this attempt toward resolution.

The group then discussed the congestion resulting from vehicles parked on the south side of S 2nd at the corner of Madison. The group decided that no matter the vehicle size, that the corner needs a "no parking here to corner" sign placed. Mike will present an ordinance update to remedy this problem at the next meeting with guidance from Darrel, Scott and Dave.

Rustin Lippincott made a request of the committee for 2 additional handicap parking spots in front of the Civic Center. Motion by Doug, 2nd by John to proceed with the addition of 2 handicap parking spots with at least one labeled for van use in front of the Civic Center. Rustin will keep the committee informed on what he receives as far as feedback once these spots are in place regarding even more ADA parking. Mike will present this ordinance change at next meeting.

Next meeting Feb 22nd at 6 pm. Topics for discussion include sidewalk request and Fairfest as well as 2016 planning. Also update from S2nd property owners as well as status of no parking sign.
