

## Notes from Public Safety & Transportation Committee meeting

Scott provided a brief update on the last findings regarding the fence at the corner of S. 2nd and Harrison. The committee decided to take no further action at this time.

Fairfiest - we slowly worked through the list they came with and ultimately asked for further and more precise details. They will bring more information to our next meeting after which we hope to have enough information to present their request to Council.

Parking in Right of Ways – Not enough time at this meeting for this topic.

Parking on Southview Drive - Motion by John and 2nd by Doug to place two signs on the north and south side of Southview Drive and Liberty Drive. Estimated distance from the corner is 60 ft in.

Handicap Parking on S. 2nd - the committee discussed this at length along with input from the Darrel (Streets Dept) and Chief Thomas (Police Dept). The committee discussed the congestion on S 2nd along with the entry points to the house. We decided to deny this request.

Trail Signage - we don't quite understand this request. The area there appears to be a request for is actually not City property. We do not feel this is our place to make a decision. We encourage council to work with Hickenbottom or to pursue painting the Stop or Yield on the sidewalk like you would see on the road but on the paved trail.
