

Public Safety & Transportation Committee Meeting Minutes, 1/4/11, Park & Recreation Office

Present: Ron Adam, Daryn Hamilton, Michael Halley, Jeff Clawson, Derrik Wulfekuhle, Park & Rec Board members

Points of discussion

Daryn Hamilton explained to the Park and Recreation board members that the Dog Park committee would like to change the location of the park from O.B. Nelson Park to Lamson Woods. Board president Dr. Terry Cochran expressed three issues the P&R board needs the Dog Park committee to address before they can support the move to Lamson Woods:

- Need for more parking spaces: the existing parking lot needs to be expanded.
- Access to water: a water line and spigot need to be installed.
- Restrooms: a permanent restroom, like the one at Pleasant Lake, needs to be built.

It was also noted that adjacent property owner Dr. William Baumann should be contacted to ensure that he has no objections to the proposed Dog Park.

Recommendations/Actions

Points of discussion

Derik Wulfekuhle reported the three issues that the Park & Rec board needs the Dog Park committee to address before they can endorse the move to Lamson Woods. Based on preliminary discussion these changes are acceptable to the DP committee, who will research the costs and logistics of each issue.

- Parking: the existing lot can be expanded to the north.
- Water: Derik confirmed with the Water Dept. that a water line can be extended from across Mint Blvd.
- Restrooms: Derik will work with a member of the Elks who might want to help with construction of a permanent restroom as a community betterment project.

Ron Adams spoke with Dr. William Baumann and reported that he fully endorses the Dog Park project.
