Seal coating budget this year \$119,000. Darrel would like to add \$51,000 from 227th street project that didnt move forward. Currently \$51,000 is in capital improvements and would be paid from there.

Seal coat - similar to road behind country club as an example.

Darrell feels this is the best use of the funds and wants to stay on top of seal coat projects so as not to move backwards with the program.

Connie moved that we redirect these funds to the seal coat program. Michael seconded. Motion carried.

Cielle Kollander would like to request a handicap spot on Lowe St. Darrell said there are other spots around town for similar situations. Her address is 413 North B.

Michael moved that we grant a handicap space on Lowe Street as long as she is in accordance with DMV handicap law. Connie seconded. Motion carried.

Discussed 18th street and sidewalk for trail. Darrell is suggesting two or three signs indicating no parking this side. Add this to agenda for full discussion and vote.

Michael asked if Darrel had spoken with Dallas Terry regarding his feasibility study. Darrel said they spoke and he didn't feel it was warranted, especially now that there is a private individual running a taxi service. Susan will send an email to Dallas.

Darrell suggested we remove handicap spot that we put in place for City Hall for Linda Briggs as it is no longer used.
