III. CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

- 1. The Home Occupation Permit shall not be transferable to any firm, individual, or another address. A substantial change in use as determined by the Zoning Administrator shall necessitate the filing of a new Home Occupation Permit application.
- 2. Each permit for a home occupation shall expire on December 31st of each calendar year and may be renewed upon the re-filing of an application accompanied by a fifty-dollar fee.
- 3. Permitted home occupations shall be those occupations which provide a personal or professional service; however, only one of such type service shall be permitted per residence.
- 4. The Home Occupation shall occupy no more than one room of the residence or in a detached garage. The use is incidental to the residential use of the dwelling.
- 5. No person other than a resident of the dwelling shall be employed on-site or report to work at the site in conduct of the home occupation. The prohibition applies to independent contractors.
- 6. This use shall not generate vehicular or pedestrian traffic in excess of that which is normally associated with residential uses in the same zone.
- 7. No parking space shall be obstructed and no additional parking space will be required for the home occupation.
- 8. There shall be no exterior indication of the home occupation, including signs on the premises, except as permitted by the sign regulations in the City code.
- 9. The use shall not create noise, odor, dust, fumes, vibration, smoke, electrical interference, or any other interference with the residential uses of adjacent property.
