

## **Trees:**

No person shall plant or remove any tree on any municipal-owned property, including street rights-of-way, without first filing an application and obtaining approval from the planning administrator. **NO** tree from the list of Not Recommended List of Trees for Fairfield shall be planted, seeded or permitted to grow on any lands within the city of Fairfield.

## **Shrubs, Plants and flowers:**

Regular Lots:

Any planting in the rights-of-way shall not be allowed to grow higher than twenty-four (24) inches from the curb without written permission from the City of Fairfield in all R1, R2, R3, R4 & R5 zoning districts.

Corner Lots:

Nothing may be planted on corner lots on the city right-of-way above eighteen (18) inches in height above the curb without written permission from the City of Fairfield in all R1, R2, R3, R4 & R5 zoning districts.

**NO** fruits or vegetables may be grown on any city right-of-way.
