## SNOW & ICE REMOVAL - - SIDEWALKS

Snow and / or ice removal from sidewalks is required within twelve hours after the snow has fallen and / or ice has formed.

It is the property owners and / or occupants responsibility for removal and shall spread suitable material, such as ice melt or sand, on the sidewalk when necessary to prevent the sidewalk from being slippery. In the event the owner and / or occupant fails to remove the snow and / or ice the City will remove it and assess the cost (**minimum \$160.00**) to the property owner.

## PARKING RESTRICTIONS



No vehicle may park on any City street for more than twenty-four consecutive hours. However, in the Central Business District, parking is only allowed for two hours at a time from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday.

**SNOW EMERGENCY:** When declared by the City, all vehicles parked in the Central Business District must be removed between 8:00 PM to 9:00 AM to allow for snow removal.

Violators will be towed and impounded at the owner's expense.

## REMINDER TO ALL DOG OWNERS

January 1 through June 30 is the time to register your dogs at City Hall for the fee of \$10.00 for spayed and neutered dogs and \$50.00 for non-spayed and non-neutered dogs. Any dog licensed after June 30 will be charged an additional \$1.00 per month. Dogs younger than 6 months do not have to be registered. Please bring the rabies certificate with you for registration purpose.



## HOME OCCUPATIONS

Home occupations are only allowed to operate with an approved permit. Permits are renewed annually in December at a cost of \$50.00. Application forms and regulations are available at City Hall or on our website at [cityoffairfieldiowa.com](http://cityoffairfieldiowa.com).

## RENTAL PROPERTY



Owners of rental property within the City of Fairfield must register their rental units with the Planning & Zoning Department in City Hall. A registration fee of \$100.00 per unit plus inspection fees will apply.
