SNOW & ICE REMOVAL - - SIDEWALKS

Snow and / or ice removal from sidewalks is required within twelve hours after the snow has fallen and / or ice has formed.

It is the property owners and / or occupants responsibility for that removal.

The owner and / or occupant shall spread suitable material, such as ice melt or sand, on the sidewalk when necessary to prevent the sidewalk from being slippery.

In the event the owner and / or occupant fails to remove the snow and / or ice the City will remove it and assess the cost to the property owner.

PARKING RESTRICTIONS



No vehicle may park on any City street for more than twenty-four consecutive hours. However, in the Central Business District, parking is only allowed for two hours at a time from nine AM to five PM Monday through Friday and no parking anytime from two AM to six AM. Violators may receive a citation and/or towing and impoundment at the owner's expense.



REMINDER TO ALL DOG OWNERS

January 1 through June 30 is the time to register your dogs at City Hall for the fee of \$10.00 for spayed and neutered dogs and \$50.00 for non-spayed and non-neutered dogs. Any dog licensed after June 30 will be charged an additional \$1.00 per month. Dogs younger than 6 months do not have to be registered. Please bring the rabies certificate with you for registration purpose.
